DYRK1A Insight:

In February we welcomed a speaker who covered Epilepsy; Identification and First-Aid.

DYRK1A Digest:

Our Monthly e-newsletter is keeping people informed about activities, stories, and research all around DYRK1A Syndrome.

DYRK1A Blog:

We've shared several blog stories on our website from families sharing their life experiences related to their child with DYRKIA Syndrome

Welcome Package:

We created a welcome packet of information to embrace new families and provide them with a sense of community. The packet has been viewed 950 times on our website. We've mailed welcome packages to 26 families; the package brings initial information that new families are eager for.

US Annual Family Meet-up:

We had a successful in-person family meet-up with 32 families and 140 people. We had a packed agenda with researchers, therapists, and families sharing their experiences. We ended our event with a fun-filled day visiting Denver Zoo on Sunday. We provided travel scholarships for several families to attend this annual event.



Awareness and Visibility

DYRKIA Awareness Day:

In August our awareness day brought a 150% increase in our website views. Our social media presence increased by more than 500% overall. We released a new resource, Common Questions, that was viewed 650 times during the month. dyrkla.org/commonquestions

Run a K for DYRK1A:

This was our third family fun run or walk that allows people to bring awareness of DYRK1A in their local communities. We had 196 individuals and 23 family groups formally participate and many more in other capacities.

Request for Proposal:

International Partnerships


Partnerships
